

Artistic murals in the parishes of Kabati and Mutune, diocese of Kitui, Kenya.

For five days in February 2017, three Spanish artists visited Kitui to paint several murals with different religious motifs in the parishes of *The Holy Family*, in Kabati, and *St. Patrick*, in Mutune.

With the help of some candidates to the seminary and some parishioners, they carried out their work as scheduled, according to the instructions previously given by Bishop Anthony Muheria.

Now, two communities in Kenya have the possibility of approaching formation and catechesis through the help of images, as it happens in most churches of the world.

The work of the team — composed of Miguel Aranguren, his brother Gabriel and his nephew Álvaro Aranguren— was highly praised by the parish priests and the faithful.



Since the experience has had such a positive impact, the Aranguren brothers are open to the idea of painting new murals in other parishes.
